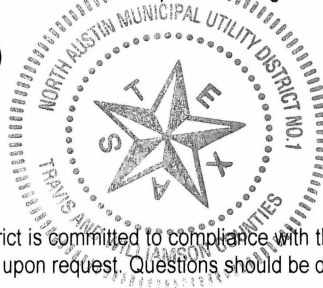


Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of North Austin Municipal Utility District No. 1 will hold a regular meeting on **Monday, April 14, 2014, at 6:00 p.m.**, at the Rattan Creek Community Center at 7617 Elkhorn Mountain Trail, Austin, Texas, for the following purposes:

1. Conduct a work session regarding proposed bills and invoices and consider action to approve payment of bills and invoices and transfers between District accounts;
2. Receive consultant reports on activities;
3. Receive general manager report, including approval of related maintenance and construction items and proposals;
4. Consider any necessary action regarding future annexation, limited district conversion, and other City of Austin related issues, including water and wastewater rate appeal and proposed JPI settlement; and
5. Review items from the Wednesday, April 16, 2014 meeting agenda (No action will be taken except as specifically posted above); and
6. Such other matters as may come before the Board.

The Board of Directors is authorized by the Texas Open Meetings Act to convene in closed or executive session for certain purposes. These purposes include receiving legal advice from its attorney (Texas Gov't Code, §551.071); discussing real property matters (§551.072); discussing gifts and donations (§551.073), discussing personnel matters (§551.074) or discussing security personnel or devices (§551.076). If the Board of Directors determines to go into executive session on any item on this agenda, the Presiding Officer will announce that an executive session will be held and will identify the item to be discussed and provision of the Texas Open Meetings Act that authorizes the closed or executive session.
