

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of North Austin Municipal Utility District No. 1 will hold a special meeting on **Tuesday, November 1, 2011, at 6:00 p.m.**, at the District Community Center at 7617 Elkhorn Mountain Trail, Austin, Texas, for the following purposes:

1. Consider taking any necessary action regarding Champion Playgrounds lawsuit;
2. Consider taking any necessary action regarding security services for the District Community Center;
3. Consider taking any necessary action regarding future annexation and limited district conversion;
4. Consider taking any necessary action regarding water billings by the City of Austin;
5. Discuss and consider necessary action regarding JPI agreement and City use of District facilities;
6. Discuss and consider approval of proposal(s) for painting;
7. Such other matters as may come before the Board.

The Board of Directors is authorized by the Texas Open Meetings Act to convene in closed or executive session for certain purposes. These purposes include receiving legal advice from its attorney (Texas Gov't Code, §551.071); discussing real property matters (§551.072); discussing gifts and donations (§551.073), discussing personnel matters (§551.074) or discussing security personnel or devices (§551.076). If the Board of Directors determines to go into executive session on any item on this agenda, the Presiding Officer will announce that an executive session will be held and will identify the item to be discussed and provision of the Texas Open Meetings Act that authorizes the closed or executive session.
