Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of North Austin Municipal Utility District No. 1 will hold a regular meeting on **Wednesday, January 16, 2013, at 6:00 p.m.**, at the District Community Center at 7617 Elkhorn Mountain Trail, Austin, Texas, for the following purposes:

1. Consider approval of the December 17, 2012 meeting minutes;
2. Receive citizens' communications;
3. Receive park and landscape maintenance report, including approval of related proposals;
4. Receive pool and community center report, including approval of related proposals;
5. Receive general manager report, including approval of related proposals for maintenance and construction items;
6. Receive bookkeeping report and consider payment for bills, invoices, investments and accounts transfers;
7. Consider approval of audit and management report for the year ended September 30, 2012, and authorize filing of the same;
8. Consider approval of Resolution Confirming Annual Review of District Investment Policy and Investment Strategy, Including Code of Ethics;
9. Review written statements of interest and qualifications regarding vacancy on the Board of Directors and take any necessary action thereon;
10. Consider appointment of Director to fill vacancy on Board of Directors;
11. Receive a report from the District's engineer;
12. Receive restrictive covenants report regarding services rendered, reporting of inspection, consider any necessary action on outstanding violations, including litigation;
13. Discuss and consider any necessary action regarding water rates;
14. Consider any necessary action regarding future annexation and limited district conversion; and

15. Such other matters as may come before the Board.

The Board of Directors is authorized by the Texas Open Meetings Act to convene in closed or executive session for certain purposes. These purposes include receiving legal advice from its attorney (Texas Gov't Code, §551.071); discussing real property matters (§551.072); discussing gifts and donations (§551.073), discussing personnel matters (§551.074) or discussing security personnel or devices (§551.076). If the Board of Directors determines to go into executive session on any item on this agenda, the Presiding Officer will announce that an executive session will be held and will identify the item to be discussed and provision of the Texas Open Meetings Act that authorizes the closed or executive session.
